Adjustments

1) The Board of Directors reserves the right to adjust Rates & Fees at any time as needed.

Residential, Commercial & Industrial

1) This rate applies to all residential, commercial, governmental, institutional, not-for-profit and industrial Customers.

Fire Hydrants

1) NCWSA must grant approval for all water purchased from fire hydrants. The monthly base fee for a hydrant meter is \$20.00 (no gallons). Usage is billed at the commercial volumetric rate.

Stand-By Agricultural Rate

1) Large agricultural users, whose operations are entirely agricultural in nature, may be granted Stand-By Agricultural Rate Status. This rate shall be ½ the base fee for the size meter installed for all months with zero consumption. Any month water is used shall be billed at commercial rate.

Residential Irrigation Water

All single-family residences will be served potable and irrigation water through one standard 5/8 x 3/4 meter. All water metered will be billed at the residential rate. It is the Customer's responsibility to design and operate any irrigation system within the constraints of the meter's flow capacity. No separate residential irrigation meters will be installed.

Mobile Home & RV Parks

1) Rates for Mobile Home & RV Parks established prior to April 28, 2011 will be based on the Commercial Rate Schedule, plus \$4.77 per SCDHEC approved mobile home site. Parks established after April 28, 2011 will be based on the Commercial Rate Schedule with no per site charge.

APPENDIX B:

Sewer Rates and Fees Effective July 1, 2021

Nothing in this Policy shall be construed or interpreted as a contract to provide Sewer Service.

Residential

1) All single-family residences will be billed for service using one standard 5/8 x 3/4 meter. The volumetric charge for residential sewer will be capped at 10,000 gallons. No separate residential irrigation meters will be installed.
